What do I need to do? One time online enrollment is quick and easy. Each time you shop, you either swipe your Kroger Plus card or enter your Alt ID at the register.


What's in it for me? The alternate ID or Kroger Plus card allows you exclusive savings while shopping in the store and access to hundreds of digital coupons online.






If you already have an account online, **sign in** and follow the **"Enroll"** steps outlined below (**highlighted in green**).
