C C# D \flat D D# E \flat E

This section shows the first five notes of the saxophone scale. Each note is represented by a half note on a treble clef staff. This section shows the next five notes of the saxophone scale. For A# B flat, the A# and B keys are pressed. For B, the B key is pressed. For C, the C key is pressed. For C# D flat, the C# and D keys are pressed. For D, the D key is pressed.

D# E \flat E F F#

This section shows the final four notes of the saxophone scale. For D# E flat, the D# and E keys are pressed. For E, the E key is pressed. For F, the F key is pressed. For F#, the F# key is pressed.
